SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 53520 of July 31, 1956, in this proceeding, established a surcharge of five percent on the long-distance rates and certain accessorial charges for the transportation of used household goods and related articles as set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A. The surcharge is scheduled to become effective September 1, 1956. The increase was authorized, following public hearings, pursuant to petition filed by the California Moving & Storage Association.

Petitioner has now requested that Decision No. 53520 be amended so as to incorporate the increase directly into the rates affected in lieu of providing a surcharge supplement. Petitioner states that small household-goods carriers will have difficulty properly applying a surcharge; that the shipping documents in use are not suitable for using a surcharge; and that a surcharge would confuse the average shipper of used household goods, thus creating adverse public relations.

In an interim order, such as here involved, reprinting of all the tariff pages concerned would not be practical. However, petitioner's request has merit. The surcharge will be incorporated into the rates and charges by means of a conversion table. The order

which follows will be made effective September 1, 1956, the same date on which the minimum rate increases established by Decision No. 53520 are scheduled to become effective.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 44919, as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 1, 1956, Supplement No. 2 Cancels Supplement No. 1, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof;
- (2) That tariff publications to be made by common carriers pursuant to this order may be made effective not earlier than the effective date hereof on not less than five days! notice to the Commission and to the public;
- (3) That in all other respects said Decision No. 44919, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be September 1, 1956.
