FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission by Decision No. 50908, dated December 28, 1954, among other things, authorized Pacific Motor Trucking Company to sell and transfer to Santa Fe Transportation Company the operative rights and property referred to in the purchase agreement, a copy of which is marked Exhibit 10 in this proceeding, and in the manner and for the consideration provided in such agreement.

By agreement, dated May 23, 1955, a copy of which is attached to the instant petition as Exhibit A, said Exhibit 10 has been superseded and is no longer of any force. The effect of Exhibit A is to delete from the proposed transfer interstate operative rights and certain rolling stock and other equipment and to reduce the purchase price for the operative rights and the tangible properties to be transferred to Santa Fe Transportation Company from \$62,755 to \$30,000 and from \$221,000 to \$45,946, respectively.

Pacific Motor Trucking Company and Santa Fe Transportation Company request the Commission to amend ordering paragraph (3) of Decision No. 50908 so as to refer to and incorporate the said agreement of May 23, 1955, in lieu of Exhibit 10.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That ordering paragraph (3) of Decision No. 50908, in Application No. 35802, is amended to read:

(3) That Pacific Motor Trucking Company within twenty days after the transfer hereinabove referred to in paragraph 2 shall have been effected, shall sell and transfer to Santa Fe Transportation Company the operative rights and property referred to in the purchase agreement dated May 23, 1955, a copy of which is attached to the petition herein, and in the manner and for the consideration provided in such agreement.

2. That in all other respects Decision No. 50908 shall remain in full force and effect.
