OPINION Joseph L. Bonita is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits and a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. Applicant seeks an order authorizing him to extend his service as a highway common carrier generally from Banning to Thermal, and from his Los Angeles area to Santa Ana, including all intermediate points. Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission. Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted as set forth in the ensuing order. Such order will also restate applicant's highway common carrier operative authority. It appears that applicant possesses the experience, equipment, personnel and financial resources to institute and maintain the operation authorized herein. A public hearing is not necessary. Applicant is hereby placed on notice that operative rights, as such, do not constitute a class of property which may be -1-

- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.
- (3) That the operative right granted by Decision No. 49325, dated November 10, 1953, in Application No. 33690, is cancelled simultaneously with the making of the filings required by and pursuant to the provisions of paragraphs (1) and (2) hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be ninety days after the date hereof.
