## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California,  
 Department of Public Works, for an order  
 authorizing the alteration and widening  
 of an existing crossing at separated  
 grades between State Route X-SJ-5-B and  
 the Sacramento Line, from Oakland via  
 Niles to Elvas, of the Southern Pacific  
 Company, in San Joaquin County, some-  
 times referred to as the "Mossdale  
 Underpass".

O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is author-  
 ized to alter and widen the existing crossing of State Route No. 5  
 (U.S. 50) at separated grades under the tracks of Southern Pacific  
 Company, near Lathrop, San Joaquin County, at the location as shown  
 by maps (Exhibit B) attached to the application, identified as a  
 portion of Crossing No. D-78.6-B. Construction and maintenance  
 expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered  
 into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement,  
 together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific  
 Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the  
 date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will  
 apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.  
 Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order  
 applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-  
 tion shall become void if not exercised within two years unless

time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
