ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to widen and reconstruct an existing crossing of State Route 37 (U.S. 40) at separated grades and to construct a crossing of State Route 37 (U.S. 40) at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, near New England Mills, Placer County, at the locations as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. A-137.0-A and AI-137.9-A, respectively. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

During the period of construction, applicant is authorized to deviate from the provisions of General Order No. 26-D to the

extent of a vertical clearance of 20 feet 6 inches above top of rail at the locations mentioned in the application, and Southern Pacific Company is authorized to operate with such impaired overhead clearances provided it issue appropriate notices to train and engine crews advising them of the impaired clearance conditions and forbidding them to ride on the tops and sides of cars.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
