O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, proposes to improve State Route 49 (Sign Route 29) northerly of the City of Napa, Napa County, and in connection therewith, proposes to construct one new crossing at grade and to alter four existing crossings at grade over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company.

IT IS ORDERED that the State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to carry out the work shown in the application as amended, all being summarized in the following table with provision for protection which shall be installed:

Width of all aforementioned crossings shall be not less than twenty-four feet with grade of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72.

Expense of construction, maintenance and elimination shall be borne in accordance with agreements now being entered into between the parties involved, and copy of said agreements shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion such costs by subsequent order.

Upon the completion of the frontage road located to the west of the Southern Pacific Company's tracks private grade crossings located approximately at Mileposts 72.05, 72.12, 72.26, 72.30, 73.34, 73.44, 73.47, 73.58, 73.65 and 73.69 shall be physically removed by Southern Pacific Company.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
