O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional track at grade across Spreckles Road in San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-98.0. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six percent. The additional track shall be at the same elevation as is the existing track at this crossing. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
