ORDER

County of Tuclumne is authorized to alter and reconstruct the crossing at grade of the Sonora-Tuclumne Road with a track of Sierra Railroad Company, (Crossing No. 39-47.4) near Sonora, Tuclumne County, as described in the application and substantially in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than forty-eight feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (General Order No. 75-B).

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Sierra Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
