O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct State Route 11 (U.S. 50) at grade across a track of Camino, Placerville and Lake Tahoe Railroad Company near Camino in El Dorado County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 18-1.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Camino, Placerville and Lake Tahoe Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be as shown in the application and grades of approach shall be not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
