SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

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Minimum Rate Tariff No. 6 nemes minimum rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in bulk in tank truck equipment. Item No. 60 of the tariff provides exceptions in the computation of distances via the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge and via the Richmond-San Rafael Ferry. These exceptions reflect safety regulations prohibiting the transportation of certain petroleum products over the bridge or the ferry.

The ferry has now been replaced by the new Richmond-San Rafael Bridge. The safety regulations applicable on the Bay Bridge will also apply on the new bridge. The tariff rule will be amended to reflect the present conditions. A public hearing is not necessary.

> Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No. 6 (Appendix "C" of Decision No. 32608, as amended) be, and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective October 1, 1956, Eleventh Revised Page 9 Cancels Tenth Revised Page 9, which page is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof;

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(2) That tariff publications required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the effective date hereof on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public; and that such required tariff publications shall be made effective not later than October 1, 1956; and

(3) That in all other respects the aforesaid Decision No. 32608, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
