ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing that by Decision No. 45469 dated March 20, 1951, in the above numbered application, a certificate of public convenience and necessity was issued to Edgar H. Compton, authorizing petroleum irregular route carrier service for the transportation of (a) crude oil in bulk, in tank trucks and tank trailers, from any point in the counties of Ventura, Los Angeles, Orange, and Riverside, to the City of Long Beach, and (b) black diesel oil and fuel oil from Long Beach and Norwalk to any point in said counties; and it further appearing that there have been no operations under said authority for more than one year, that applicant is using his equipment for other purposes and has no insurance on file for this service, and that said Edgar H. Compton by letter dated August S, 1956 has requested that his operative rights be revoked, now therefore,

IT IS HEREBY FOUND that Edgar H. Compton is no longer conducting and has abandoned his petroleum irregular route carrier operation as authorized by said Decision No. 45469.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by said Decision No. 45469 is hereby revoked and all rates, rules and regulations governing the operations here involved are cancelled.
