FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 53592, dated August 21, 1956, the Commission authorized General Telephone Company of California to execute a supplemental indenture and to issue, sell and deliver \$20,000,000 principal amount of its first mortgage bonds.

The application, as originally filed, set forth that the initial redemption price of the bonds would be the initial public offering price plus three per cent of the principal amount of the bonds, or 103% of the principal amount, whichever is greater. The company now reports, however, that due to market conditions, it has found it necessary to revise the proposed terms of the bonds so as to provide that the initial redemption price will be the initial public offering price plus the rate of interest on the bonds, or 100% of the principal amount of the bonds, plus the rate of interest, whichever is greater. It has requested a supplemental order from the Commission approving the proposed change.
