O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct industrial lead tracks at grade in and along East Worth Street across Beighle Alley, "A" Street and "B" Street in the City of Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the locations described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that the proposed track portion of East Worth Street is not at present open to public use and travel, and this order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry involved contemplates immediate construction and asks that the authorization requested be made effective immediately.

Consequently, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
