SECOND INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

By supplemental application filed May 4, 1956, Lester J. Geijsbeek and John H. Geijsbeek, a partnership engaged in the transportation of property as a highway common carrier, seek authority to continue to maintain rates lower than the established minimum rates for the transportation of rough lumber from Lyman Springs and Mineral to Chico.

In its Decision No. 53148 in this proceeding the Commission was of the opinion that public hearing should be held in this application and that pending final determination, applicant should be authorized to continue to publish the rates here involved. Authority to publish the rates is scheduled to expire September 14, 1956. Public hearing in this proceeding is scheduled for October 15, 1956.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 53148, dated May 28, 1956, in this

proceeding be and it is hereby extended to December 31, 1956,
unless sooner changed or further extended by order of the
Commission.
