The City of Madera is authorized to deviate from the provisions of Decision No. 53740 dated September 11, 1956, by opening Cleveland Avenue at grade over track of Southern Pacific Company to public use during September 19 to 24 inclusive, 1956, provided that during the period of such use police officer protection is maintained at the crossing in lieu of two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals specified in said Decision.
