O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one drill track and one spur track at grade across Tervin Avenue in Salinas, Monterey County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-120.74-C. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), equipped with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industrial plant to be served by the trackage involved herein is now under construction and the applicant has requested that an immediate authorization be made upon granting of the application. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
