OPINION AND ORDER

Garberville Water Company, Inc., applicant herein, distributes water in the vicinity of Garberville, Humboldt County. It now seeks authority to issue to Elmer W. Hurlbutt, its vice-president, a \$5,000 demand note bearing 5% per annum interest to refinance existing indebtedness incurred in the purchase of additional pipes and materials for the expansion of its facilities.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary, that the application should be granted, that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for by the issue of the note herein authorized is reasonably required by applicant for the purpose specified herein, and that such purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Garberville Water Company, Inc., on and after the effective date hereof and on or before December 31, 1956, may issue a note in the principal amount of not exceeding \$5,000 for the purpose set forth in this application, such note to be in, or substantially in, the same form as that filed in this proceeding as Exhibit "B".

2. Garberville Water Company, Inc. shall file with the Commission a report, or reports, as required by General Order No. 24-A, which order, insofar as applicable, is made a part of this order.

3. The authority herein granted will become effective when applicant has paid the minimum fee prescribed by Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$25.
