The Western Pacific Railroad Company and The Oakland
Terminal Railway are authorized to construct a line of railroad along
Union Street, crossing Twelfth, Tenth, Eighth, Seventh, and
Fifth Streets and across Third, Union and Magnolia Streets and across
the Twelfth Street line of Key System Transit Lines in the City of
Oakland, Alameda County, to be identified as shown in the following
tabulation. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior
to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a width to conform
to the portion of the streets now graded with tops of rails flush with
the roadway and with grades of approach as indicated in the application. Protection at the crossings shall be as indicated in the
tabulation.

Interlocking plans for the crossing of the Key System Transit Lines' 12th Street Line between Union and Poplar Streets shall be presented in accordance with Section 1 of General Order No. 33-B.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be apportioned by an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto and if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicants shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicants allege that in accordance with an Interstate Commerce Commission decision, construction work along Union Street must be started by October 1, 1956.

Consequently, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
