O R D E R

The City of El Segundo is authorized to construct Sheldon Street at grade across a track of El Segundo Line of the Pacific Electric Railway Company in the City of El Segundo in Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 6BA-18.53. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 30 feet and grades of approach not greater than 6 percent on the north and to extend from the top of rail to top of pavement approximately 40 feet south of track. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by 2 standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B), reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
