ORDER

City of Compton is authorized to construct Manville
Street at grade across two main and two spur tracks of the Long Beach
Line of the Pacific Electric Mailway Company in the City of Compton
in Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application
to be identified as Crossing No. 6L-12.66. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines
two feet outside of rails. The Pacific Electric Railway Company
shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing
shall be not less than 60 feet (including sidewalk area) and grades
of approach not greater than 4 percent. Construction shall be equal
or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection
shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order
No. 75-B) supplemented by automatic crossing gates.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year,

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
