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FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The State of California, Department of Public Works, has been authorized to construct State Highway Route 4 (U.S. 99) at separated grades under the track of Southern Pacific Company, at Galt, Sacramento County, as set forth in Decision No. 53177, dated June 4, 1956 in the above numbered application.

The aforesaid Department of Public Works hereby is authorized to construct a crossing at grade for temporary use as a detour at the location and in the manner described in the First Supplemental Application filed August 22, 1956, to be identified as Crossing No. DG-112.86 in lieu of Crossing No. DG-112.85 authorized in said Decision No. 53177. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Upon completion of the project, Crossing No. DG-112.81 and DG-112.86 shall be abandoned and closed.

In all other respects Decision No. 53177 shall remain in full force and effect.
