O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a second main track at grade across Monroe Street in the City of Indio and County of Riverside, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-609.7. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement between the parties, attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the street to be graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding five per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within

one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
