O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct one branch track at grade across Timberlane Avenue and Peach Avenue in the community of Hesperia, San Bernardino County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 2D-2.2 and 2D-2.6, respectively. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year,

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
