SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission's attention having been directed to certain errors in its Decision No. 53310 issued herein on June 26, 1956, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That said Decision No. 53310 is hereby amended by substituting First Revised Page 1 of Appendix A, attached hereto, in the place and stead of Original Page 1 of Appendix A to said Decision No. 53310.

2. That ordering paragraph No. (3) of said Decision No. 53310 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(3) That the operating authority heretofore granted to Walter Alves, doing business as Alves Service Transportation, by ordering paragraph No. 1(a) of Decision No. 49247, dated October 27, 1953, in Application No. 32047, and transferred to Alves Service Transportation, Inc., by authority of Decision No. 52077, dated October 18, 1955, in Applications Nos. 37317 and 37318, and the operating authority granted to Walter Alves, doing business as Alves Service Transportation, by Decision No. 51656, dated July 5, 1955, as modified by Decision No. 52561, dated January 31, 1956, both in Application No. 36707, are hereby revoked and canceled, said revocation and cancellation to take effect simultaneously with the institution of service under the authority granted herein (by Decision No. 53310)."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

*Alves Service Transportation, Inc., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport general commodities between San Francisco Territory and Crockett, on the one hand, and Los Angeles Territory, on the other hand. Such authority does not include the right to render service to, from or between intermediate points.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

- (1) Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
- (2) Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
- (3) Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- (4) Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.
- (5) Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
- (6) Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
