OPINION AND ORDER

In this proceeding Ira J. Haas requests a license to engage in business as a motor transportation broker at 1231 East Seventh Street, Los Angeles, California.

It is asserted that applicant is an employee, viz., office manager of the Los Angeles Branch of National Reefer Service, Inc., a Nebraska corporation, the head office of which is Omaha, Nebraska. The corporation has joined in the application as required by Section 4833 of the California Public Utilities Code. It is stated that applicant's business consists of arranging for transportation in interstate commerce of non-manufactured agricultural commodities which are exempt from interstate regulation by Section 203 (b)(6) of the Interstate Commerce Act.

Following our regular procedure in applications requesting a license as a motor transportation broker a staff investigation was made in this matter. We now find that to grant the license as requested would not be in the public interest. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application is hereby denied.

This order shall be effective twenty days after the date hereof.
