SECOND INTERIM SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By this supplemental petition Winans Bros. Trucking Co., a corporation, seeks authority to continue to maintain in its highway common carrier tariff a rate less than the otherwise established minimum rate for the transportation of lumber from Hayfork to Redding. Hearing has been had on the supplemental petition and the matter has been taken under submission. The evidence of record is being considered by the Commission.

Petitioner's present authority respecting the publication of the rate here involved is scheduled to expire November 1, 1956. In order to prevent lapse of this authority pending final determination by the Commission of this matter, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Winans Bros. Trucking Co. be and it is hereby authorized, on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public, to publish and file a rate of 18 cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 30,000 pounds, to expire December 15, 1956, for the transportation of lumber and forest products from Hayfork to Redding.

This order shall become effective five days after the date hereof.
