O R D E R

The City of Redlands is authorized to construct Sylvan Boulevard at grade across the tracks of the Redlands Branch of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and the Redlands Branch of the Southern Pacific Company in the City of Redlands in San Bernardino County, at the locations described in the application to be identified as Crossings Nos. 2U-10.7 and BP-549.7. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and the Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost on their respective railroads between such lines. Widths of crossings shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, with approaches paved on the railroads' rights of way. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material, at each crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
