OPINION AND ORDER

H. B. Hickey, Jr., doing business as Hickey Warehouse Company, seeks authority to discontinue public utility warehouse operations at Ontario and to cancel his tariff on file with the Commission.

The application states that at the present time there are no patrons using applicant's facilities and that he has had no calls for service nor performed any service as a public utility warehouseman during the past several years. However, operating revenues of \$120,411.22 and \$103,316.10 were reported by applicant for public utility warehousing for the years 1954 and 1955, respectively. The discrepancy between the application and the verified reports filed with this Commission has been called to applicant's attention. He has informed the Commission, by letter, that the application is correct and that the annual reports erroneously reported nonutility revenues as public utility warehouse income.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The sought authority to discontinue service and to cancel the tariff will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

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IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that H. B. Hickey, Jr., doing business as Hickey Warehouse Company, be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue service as a public utility warehouseman at Ontario and that his Warehouse Tariff Cal.P.U.C. No. 1 be and it is hereby canceled.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
