O R D E R

Department of Public Works, State of California, in connection with the improvement of State Route V-SB-2-Q,G,F, is authorized to construct a crossing at grade across a main line track of Southern Pacific Company near Elwood, Santa Barbara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-357.1. Construction expenses shall be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement to be entered into between the parties. An executed copy of said agreement shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order

No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
