SECOND INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

By Decisions Nos. 52343, 52773 and 53347, in this proceeding, Walkup Drayage & Warehouse Company was granted authority, under Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code, to transport property for S & W Fine Foods and Equitable Cash Grocery at rates less than the established minimum rates. The authority granted is scheduled to expire November 3, 1956.

IT IS ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 53347 is extended to February 1, 1957.
