OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant has been conducting a public utility warehouse operation in Los Angeles since 1953.¹ By this application it seeks authority to discontinue the operation and requests that its certificate of public convenience and necessity be revoked.

The application states that at the present time there are no patrons using applicant's facilities. It also states that, because of the restricted scope of the certificate, the volume of business offered to applicant has been negligible and the revenue derived therefrom insufficient to maintain the public warehouse; and that applicant is unable to develop any further business under this certificate.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The sought authority to discontinue service will be granted. The operating right in question will be revoked. Also, applicant's tariff on file with the Commission will be canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) That Claired, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue service as a public utility warehouseman at Los Angeles.

The operating right was acquired by applicant from Pacific Transportation and Warehouse Co., Inc. under authority of Decision No. 48602 of May 19, 1953, in Application No. 34266. It authorizes the storage of certain specified commodities.

(2) That the warehouse operating right acquired byClaired, Inc. by Decision No. 48602 dated May 19, 1953, in Applica-tion No. 34266 be and it is hereby revoked.

(3) That applicant's Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C.No. 2 be and it is hereby canceled.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
