ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION AND FURTHER EXTENDING EFFECTIVE DATE OF DECISION NO. 53262

Donald S. Praeger, respondent herein, by petition filed October 24, 1956 renews his request for reconsideration of Decision No. 53262 with respect to the imposition by the Commission of the suspension of respondent's Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 1-8351 for five days.

Each and every allegation contained in said petition has been considered. The matters alleged in the petition have been given consideration by the Commission in its Decision No. 53262 and again in connection with respondent's petition for rehearing which was denied October 16, 1956. No good cause having been shown why the suspension of permit ordered in Decision No. 53262 should be modified or rescinded, the instant petition for reconsideration will be denied.

The respondent in a petition filed October 18, 1956 sought an extension of the effective date of said Decision No. 53262. This petition was granted by the Commission in its order dated October 23, 1956 providing for the commencement of the period of suspension of the permit at 12:01 a.m., November 16, 1956. It was intended in Decision No. 53262 and in the order extending the effective date of that decision that the respondent have a reasonable time in which to arrange his affairs so as to comply with the suspension

requirement, or, in the case of the order extending the effective date of the decision, to have opportunity to seek judicial review.

In light of the circumstances, the Commission on its own motion will further extend the effective date of the aforesaid decision.

A petition for further reconsideration having been-filed, and consideration having been given to each and every allegation,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for further reconsideration filed October 24, 1956 in this proceeding is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of Decision No. 53262 is hereby further extended for a period of thirty days from and after November 13, 1956. Should a petition for writ of review of said decision be filed within that time, said effective date shall be and it is hereby further extended to include the period of pendency of said petition for writ of review, or until the further order of this Commission.
