ORDER SETTING ASIDE SUBMISSION

3. Applicants shall produce the documents underlying Exhibit No. 2.
4. Applicants are directed to file a statement of their rights as a motor common carrier in interstate commerce.
5. Any additional exhibits which applicants or protestants desire to file must be served and filed at least ten days in advance of the hearing date.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the submission of this matter on September 26, 1956 be, and it is, set aside.

2. That this application be, and it is, set for further hearing before Examiner John Power at 9:30 A.M. on Friday, December 7, 1956, in the Commission's courtroom at Los Angeles, California.
