ORDER

Eolton Inter-Urban Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across County Road 21 near El Centro, Imperial County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 49-702.2-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superclovation and of a width to conform to the portion of the read new graded, with tops of rails flush with the readway and with grades. of approach not exceeding 1.5 percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant allogor that the industry to be served by this crossing is in need of immediate service. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
