SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 names minimum rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of property in Los Angeles and Orange Counties. The tariff is governed by Western Classification No. 75, Cal.P.U.C.-W.C. No. 8 of G. H. Dumas, Agent. This classification has now been superseded by Western Classification No. 76. No changes in the rules or in the ratings are involved. However, the rating items have been renumbered, making it necessary to revise various references in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 to classification provisions to correspond with the numbering in the new classification. The necessary tariff changes will be made. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as amended) be and it hereby is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 1, 1957, Fifth Revised Page 8 Cancels Fourth Revised Page 8, Fifth Revised Page 22 Cancels Fourth Revised Page 22, and Fifth Revised Page 30 Cancels Fourth Revised Page 30, which pages are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

- (2) That tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the tariff changes herein involved.
- (3) That in all other respects the aforesaid Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.

*11-E Cancels 11-D	DEFINITION OF TECHNICAL TERMS (Concluded) (Items Nos. 10 and 11) (j) SPLIT DELIVERY SHIPMENT means a shipment consisting of several component parts delivered to (a) one consignee at more than one point of destination, or (b) more than one consignee at one or more points of destination, the composite shipment weighing (or transportation charges computed upon a weight of) not less than 4,000 pounds, said shipment being shipped by one consignor at one point of origin and charges thereon being paid by the consignor when there is more than one consignee. (j-a) TOW CAR means a motor vehicle which has been altered or designed and equipped for and exclusively used in the business of towing or is otherwise exclusively used to render assistance to other vehicles. *(k) WESTERN CLASSIFICATION means Western Classification No. 76 of G. H.Dumas, Agont, and supplements thereto or reissues thereof when the provisions of said supplements or reissues have been approved by the Commission.
20-A Cancels 20	Rates provided in this tariff are minimum rates, established pursuant to the City Carriers' Act, and the Highway Carriers' Act. They apply for the transportation of property by carriers as defined in said City Carriers' Act, and radial highway common carriers and highway contract carriers, as defined in said Highway Carriers' Act. Rates, rules and regulations named in this tariff shall not apply to transportation by independent-contractor subhaulers when such transportation is performed for other carriers. This exception shall not be construed to exempt from the tariff provisions carriers for whom the independent contractors are performing transportation service.
