## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A-Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A names minimum rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of property within and between the cities of Alameda, Albany, Berkeley, Emeryville, Oskland and Piedmont. The tariff is governed by Western Classification No. 75, Cal.P.U.C.-W.C. No. 8 of G.H. Dumas, Agent. This classification has now been supersoded by Western Classification No. 76. No changes in the rules or in the ratings are involved. However, the rating items have been renumbered, making it necessary to revise various references in City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A-Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A to classification provisions to correspond with the numbering in the new classification. The necessary tariff changes will be made. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) That City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A-Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 41362, as amended) be and it hereby is further amended by incorporating therein to become

- (2) That tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the tariff changes herein involved.
- (3) That in all other respects the aforesaid Decision No. 41362, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

INDEPENDENT-CONTRICTOR SUBHLULER means any carrier who renders service for a principal carrier, for a specified recompense, for a specified result, under the central of the principal as to the result of the work only and not as to the means by which such result is accomplished.  OUTHLU means transportation of property in City Delivery and Shipping as defined herein.  POINT OF DESTINITION means the precise location at which property is tendered for physical delivery into the custody of the consignee or his agent.  POINT OF GRIGIN means the precise location at which property is physically delivered by the consigner or his agent into the custody of the carrier for transportation.
