O P I N I O N

Miles Motor Transport System is engaged in the transportation of property in California as a certificated carrier and requests the removal of all weight restrictions from its operations.

As justification for the authority sought, applicant alleges that it operates both as a permitted and certificated carrier; that the weight restrictions have led to violations of its certificate due to confusion among its employees; that the removal of comparable restrictions from other carriers has placed applicant at a competitive disadvantage and that applicant's customers have requested a more complete service.

After consideration, the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That subparagraphs (e), (f) and (g) of ordering paragraph (2) of Decision No. 47105 dated May 5, 1952, in Application No. 30262 and as amended by Decision No. 47994 dated December 2, 1952, in Application No. 30262, are hereby deleted therefrom.

(2) That within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
