Frank's Trucking, a corporation, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport:

- I. GENERAL COMMODITIES between all points in the San Francisco-East Bay Drayage Zone as described in Appendix B attached hereto.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

- a. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
- b. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps) ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses, bus chassis.
- c. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- d. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerated equipment.
- e. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.
- f. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper type trucks.
- g. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles, equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.

- A. INSECTICIDES OR FUNGICIDES, AGRICULTURAL, as listed under that heading in Items Nos. 24505 through 24572 of Western Classification No. 75, Cal. P.U.C. No. 8, George H. Dumas, Agent, on the issue date thereof and Supplement No. 46 thereto.
- B. IRON OR STEEL, VIZ.:
 - Bars
 - Plate or sheet
 - Terne plate or tin plate
- C. MACHINERY OR MACHINES, OR PARTS NAMED, as listed under that heading in Items Nos. 27145 through 31920 of Western Classification No. 75, Cal. P.U.C. No. 8, George H. Dumas, Agent, on the issue date thereof and Supplements Nos. 41, 46 48 and 50 thereto.
- D. MISCELLANEOUS COMMODITIES, VIZ.:
 - Bags, burlap, gunny, ixtle (istle), jute, sisal or paper
 - Cans, sheet iron or steel
 - Can tops or bottoms
 - Drums, empty shipping, iron or steel
 - Fibreboard
 - Pallets, iron, steel, wood, paper or pulpboard
 - Pulpboard
