SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 53170, dated May 28, 1956, in Application No. 37961, the Commission removed a 20,000-pound weight restriction from the operative rights of E. Guy Warren, doing business as Warren Transportation Company. On June 26, 1956, the Commission issued an order granting rehearing. During the interim, however, comparable weight restrictions have been removed from the operative rights of competing carriers.

After consideration, the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that applicant herein should be accorded the same treatment as other carriers in the field and that a public hearing would serve no useful purpose.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the order granting rehearing in the above matter is hereby revoked and that Decision No. 53170 is hereby reaffirmed.
