O R D E R

The State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct State Route I-Men-15-A (Sign Route 20) at separated grades over the track of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, near Calpella, Mendocino County, at the location as shown by Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 5-120.5-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order 26-D. During the period of construction temporary impaired vertical clearance above top of rail of 20' 0" is authorized and Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to operate with such temporary impaired clearance provided it issue appropriate bulletins to train and engine crews advising them of the impaired clearance condition and forbidding them to ride on the tops and sides of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
