O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Alice Street in the City of Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. D-6.95. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with level grades of approach. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry to be served by this spur track wishes to avoid expensive delay and has requested authorization as soon as possible.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
