Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 76th Avenue in the City of Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that 76th Avenue is not at present open to public use and travel, and this order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industry alleges that it requires immediate rail service in order to ship some cars of materials which are in its yards. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
