ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appears that pursuant to Commission Decision No. 49864, dated March 30, 1954, in Application No. 35215 Ray Cobb acquired the operative rights issued by Decision No. 44371, dated June 20, 1950, in Application No. 31053; and that by applicant Cobb's own written admission dated August 31, 1956, he has carried on no for-hire service under his certificate of public convenience and necessity subsequent to July, 1955;

And it further appears from Commission investigations that applicant has violated numerous provisions of General Order No. 99, with regard to keeping records and the condition of his equipment;

It is found that Ray J. Cobb has abandoned and relinquished all rights under the above-mentioned certificate of public convenience and necessity, and that he should be required to have his participation in the agency tariff to which he is a party canceled.

Now Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by said Decision No. 44371 and acquired pursuant to said Decision No. 49864 by Ray Cobb is hereby revoked; and that he is hereby directed to cause to be canceled, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and public his

participation in tariffs naming rates and rules governing the operations herein involved.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Ray Cobb by delivering it to him at 120 Chester Avenue, Bakersfield, California.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon Ray Cobb unless said Ray Cobb, before the effective date, shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order of revocation, denying the facts set forth herein as constituting an abandonment of said certificate and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
