OPINION AND ORDER

In this application the Commission is asked to make an order authorizing Motor Street Car Service, Inc., to transfer operative rights for the transportation of passengers in and about the City of Santa Rosa, together with seven motor buses and miscellaneous tools.

The application shows that Motor Street Car Service, Inc., has concluded to discontinue its passenger carrier operations and to wind up and dissolve. Its directors have passed a resolution looking toward the sale of its operative rights and tangible properties to the City of Santa Rosa for the sum of \$5,250, plus the assumption of outstanding tickets estimated to amount to approximately \$900, which resolution has been approved by a majority of the shareholders. The City Council of the City of Santa Rosa has passed a resolution designating Chris Badenhop and Mabel Dorothy Badenhop, as the vendees to receive the operative rights and equipment and the transfer will be made directly to them.

The arrangements will permit a continuation of the service to the public without interruption. Under the circumstances set forth in the application, we are of the opinion, and so find, that the transfer, as requested, will not be adverse to the public interest and that an ex parte order should be entered granting this application; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Motor Street Car Service, Inc., may transfer to Chris Badenhop and Mabel Dorothy Badenhop the operative rights acquired by it under authorization granted by Decision No. 44935, Decision No. 47504 and Decision No. 46344, and the operative equipment referred to in this application.
2. On not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public, effective concurrently with the consummation of such transfer, applicants shall supplement or reissue the tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission naming rates, rules, regulations and schedules governing the common carrier operations here involved to show that Motor Street Car Service, Inc., has withdrawn or canceled and Chris Badenhop and Mabel Dorothy Badenhop have adopted or established, as their own, said rates, rules, regulations and schedules.

3. The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of the rights and equipment herein authorized to be transferred.

4. This order will become effective on the date hereof.
