O P I N I O N

Leonard Shaha, doing business as Petrolia Stage, and presently rendering a passenger stage service for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between South Fork and Ferndale via Capetown and Petrolia in Humboldt County, requests authority to discontinue said service.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that he transported a total of 44 passengers during the year 1955 for a total revenue of \$73.50; and that due to the closing of two large mills within the area his revenue, so far, for 1956 is even less.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require a continuation of said service. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That Leonard Shaha, doing business as Petrolia Stage, is hereby authorized to discontinue service for the transportation

of passengers, their baggage and express, between South Fork and Ferndale and intermediate points via Capetown and Petrolia.

(2) That the operating authority granted in the following decisions is hereby revoked:
