OPINION

Walter Del Carlo was, and San Leandro Freight Lines is, a highway carrier engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits issued to Walter Del Carlo by this Commission and transferred by him to San Leandro Freight Lines.

San Leandro Freight Lines now seeks an order authorizing it to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general commodities as successor to Walter Del Carlo between various points in California.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

A public hearing was held on November 21, 1956 before Examiner John Power at San Francisco. Protestants assisted in

developing the record by cross-examination. From the pleadings and the evidence adduced at the hearing it appears that San Leandro Freight Lines is not one of the type entitled to a certificate under Decision No. 50448, in Case No. 5478.

The Commission having considered the application and representations filed herein, Now Therefore

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 35554 is denied.
