O R D E R

The State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct Main Street at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company in Chualar, Monterey County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. E-129.2. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-six feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals. (General Order No. 75-B).

Upon completion, Chualar River Road, Crossing No. E-129.4, about 1,300 feet southeasterly, shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become

void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
