 Los Angeles for a grade separation of Paramount Boulevard under The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad near the town of Rivera, County of Los Angeles.

O R D E R

The County of Los Angeles of the State of California is authorized to construct Paramount Boulevard near the town of Rivera at separated grades under the main line tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, in the manner described in the application, as amended October 8, 1956, and at the location as shown on Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-150.4-B. Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties, and a copy of said executed agreement shall be filed with the Commission within ninety days after the effective date of this order. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above

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conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
