O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Santa Fe Avenue, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BG-495.6-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by existing crossing signals and floodlights with suitable relocations on the north side of the crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified

if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the industry to be served is in need of immediate rail service over this facility and requests a waiver of the usual 20-day waiting period. The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
