(2) That, as of August 28, 1956, ordering paragraph (3) of Decision No. 53654, in Application No. 36445, is deleted.

(3) That, in all respects, Decision No. 49325 is in full force and effect.

- C. Between Elsinore, Hemet and the Los Angeles area via U. S. Highway 395 and State Highway 74 to Riverside, thence via U. S. Highways 60, 70-99 to the Los Angeles area, including intermediate points along, and points laterally within 3 miles of, said highways 395 and 74.
- D. Between Yucaipa and the Los Angeles area via unnumbered highways to junction with U. S. Highway 99, thence via U. S. Highway 70-99 to the Los Angeles area, including intermediate points along, and points laterally within 3 miles of, said unnumbered highways.

The operative authorities granted by Decision No. 53654 are effective only to the extent that they do not duplicate or parallel any other highway common carrier rights applicant may possess as of August 28, 1956.
